From Wien-Mitte you can take the Underground, U 3, direction Ottakring, to Stephansplatz. At Stephansplatz, you can change to U 1, direction Reumannplatz, and get off at Südtiroler Platz, right next to Südbahnhof.

**IIASA** can be reached by public transport (post bus) from Südtiroler Platz (approx. 3 minutes walk from Hotel Prinz Eugen). Turn right when leaving the hotel, at the next traffic light cross the "Gürtel". There is a big bus station in front of Südbahnhof, to the right of it is the underground station. Go to stop no. 22 – 24 and look for the buses going in the direction 'Eisenstadt', buses no. 566/567/766 (times see above).

## **How to reach IIASA** by public transport:

Take the Underground (U 1) from Stephansplatz, direction Reumannplatz, to Südtiroler Platz. The big bus station in front of the "Südbahnhof" is right close to the exit from the Underground. Go to stop no. 22 - 24 and look for the post buses going in the direction 'Eisenstadt', buses no. 566/567/766.

Public transport tickets in Vienna:

Besides the Vienna Card, the following tickets are available:

24-hour season ticket 4,30 € 72-hour season ticket 10,90 € Single ride tickets 1,50 €

These tickets are available at the ticket sales offices of the Vienna Transport Authority, at tobacconists and from vending machines in the underground stations; the 72-hour season ticket is also available in the Tourist Information Offices. Single tickets are also available from the vending machines in the vehicles themselves (including single-ticket surcharge altogether  $1.50 \in$  have coins ready!).

The ticket sales offices of the Vienna Transport Authority (Wiener Linien) can also provide information about other forms of ticket and sell a map of the public transport network.

The cost for a taxi from the airport to Vienna is approx. €27.--.
