We suggest you take the shuttle bus service from the airport to Schwedenplatz. From Schwedenplatz you can take the Underground, U 1, direction Reumannplatz, to Stephansplatz (1 stop).

There is also a new, fast train connection (however more expensive) between the airport and Vienna (Wien-Mitte) ('City Airport Train – CAT'):

From Wien-Mitte you can take the Underground, U 3, direction Ottakring, to Stephansplatz.

How to reach IIASA by public transport:

Take the Underground (U 1) from Stephansplatz, direction Reumannplatz, to Südtiroler Platz. Look for the exit showing bus and train signs. **The bus station that used to be in front of the “Südbahnhof” building has been moved across Laxenburger Strasse (corner area Laxenburger Strasse/Gürtel)!**

Public transport tickets in Vienna:

Besides the Vienna Card, the following tickets are available:

Single ride tickets 1.70 €

24-hour season ticket 4.30 €

72-hour season ticket 10.90 €

These tickets are available at the ticket sales offices of the Vienna Transport Authority, at tobacconists and from vending machines in the underground stations (have coins ready for the €1.70 tickets!); the 72-hour season ticket is also available in the Tourist Information Offices.

The ticket sales offices of the Vienna Transport Authority (Wiener Linien) can also provide information about other forms of ticket and sell a map of the public transport network.

The cost for a taxi from the airport to Vienna is approx. €28.--.
