Giorgio worked at IIASA between 1979 and 1984, on leave from the Politechnical Institute of Turin, Italy. He first came to IIASA to run a task on Public Facility Location within the Human Settlements and Services Area, he then moved to Regional Development where he worked on the clustering tendencies of populations. Previously he had worked as a researcher at the Italian Association for Housing Research and as a consultant on urban and regional planning for the Regional Authority of Piemonte.

He was acknowledged by his peers as an outstanding, creative urban scientist. Those of us who knew him well will fondly remember him as a sincere friend and individualist, who was fervently concerned with the welfare of IIASA.

He leaves a wife and two children.
