

Xiubin LI is a research scientist at the Chinese Academy of Sciences (CAS). He served as the deputy director of the Institute of Geographical Science and Natural Resources Research at the academy from 1999 to 2007.

His research fields include land use change and the impact of land use change on food security and water resources. He has published widely in national and international journals and chapters in books. Dr. Li was engaged in several expert advisory boards, e.g. the international jury of Swiss-ReSource Award, the advisory board of the geo-science division of the Natural Science Foundation of China (NSFC).
