# LUMENS and INDOBIOM\* for Planning and Policy Assessment Purposes

\* Indonesia Biosphere Management Model as regional adaptation of GLOBIOM

### Background

In September 2014, a research school activity was done at IIASA as a first effort in the regional adaptation of the Global Biosphere Management Model (GLOBIOM) in Indonesia. The research school accomplished land cover simulation adaptation as the main task required for input data preparation. Further adaptation of input data and the model requires input from key stakeholders to identify adaptation strategy based on data availability and policy assessment needs. Furthermore, the adaptation requires clear strategies to optimize synergy between INDOBIOM and LUMENS, which are in need of feedbacks from relevant stakeholders. Finally, initial discussions about scenarios to be analyzed using the models come in naturally and inseparable to the other discussions.

### Objectives

- 1. Update the progress of the Tropical Flagship Initiative to policy makers in Jambi and East Kalimantan Province as key stakeholders
- 2. Introduce potential contribution of TFI models to policy formulation
- 3. Identify further policy support needs to be included in TFI modeling activities
- 4. Validating data usage for regional adaptation of GLOBIOM to INDOBIOM
- 5. Identify potential scenarios to be included in TFI modeling activities
