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TFIAM mandate

1. Integrate knowledge from science bodies in an integrated assessment framework and support the policy process with scenario analyses ... (which scenarios would be helpful?)
2. Produce special reports on request
(in 2024: guidance document on non-technical measures;
reports/meetings in cooperation with TFRN, HTAP, FICAP, ..)
3. Stimulate national integrated assessment capacity and exchange experiences (challenge is to include EECCA experts ... workshop?)

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Information on the Convention

1. **Sep 2022: EMEP/WGE 8**
 - approved scientific input to the Gothenburg Review, including CIAM scenario
 - ex post analysis forthcoming
 - Research strategy to include equity issues
2. **Dec 2022: EB42**
 - adopted results of the Gothenburg Review and formed ad hoc group to decide on further steps
 - EB42 also adopted the Cost of Inaction report
 - EB42 requested further work on methane and ammonia scenarios; non-technical measures and outreach to EECCA countries
3. **Mar 2023: 7th Saltsjöbaden workshop**
 - set health target, TFRN to include agricultural methane
4. **Apr 2023: Webinar organized by WGSR/EB ad hoc group**
 - focus on methane, need for “new policy instrument”, no clear scenario request: “in between”
5. **Apr 2023: EMEP-WGE bureau meeting**
 - discussed effective ozone reduction strategies
